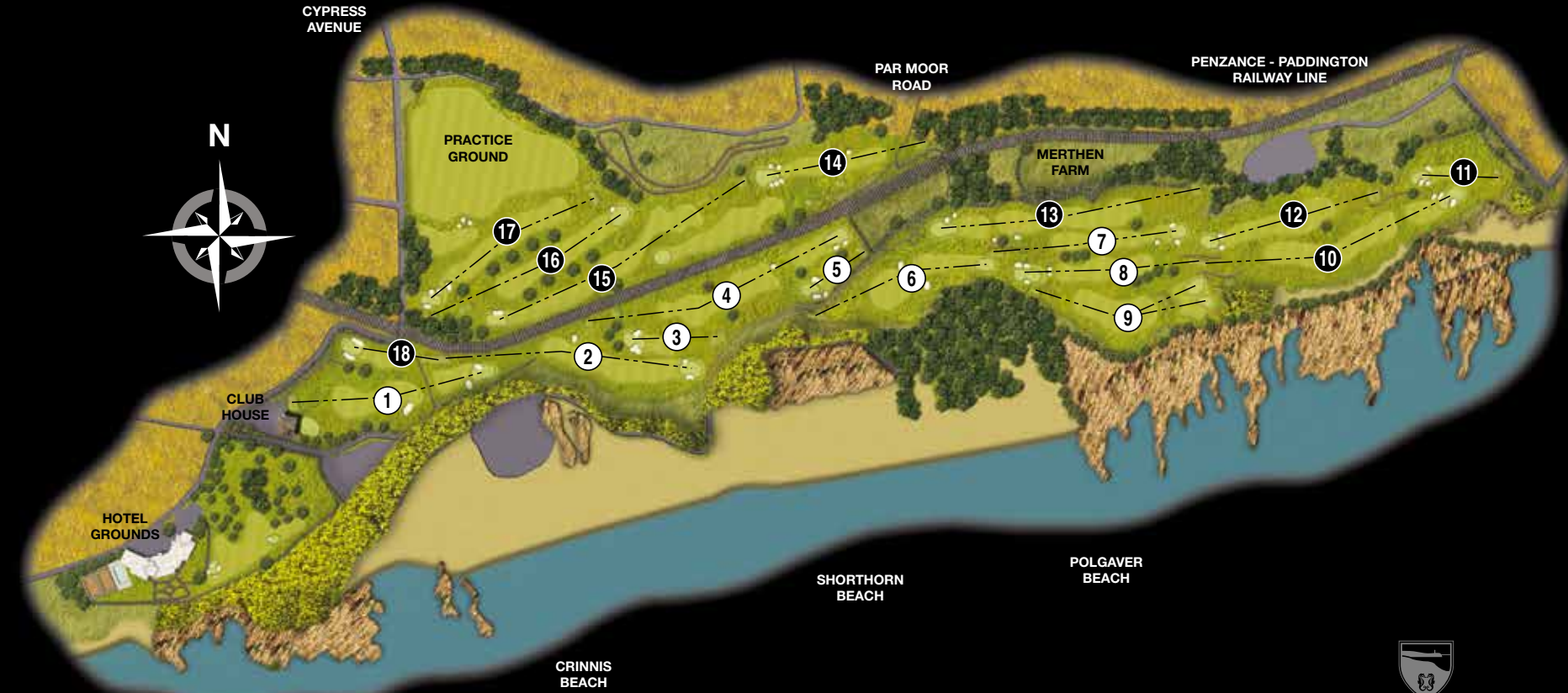


- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS**
- Beyond any fence or beyond any hedge bounding the course. In or beyond the demarcation line between the 17th and the practice ground and the extension of that line if on the path.
 - Over the edge of the cliffs.
 - Over the fence bounding the railway line.
 - Playing the 5th the ball is out of bounds when, past the first white stake, it is over the hedge on the left, going to the 5th green.
 - Over the hedge on either side of the lane when playing the 6th.
 - Within the bounds marked by white stakes around the green keepers' shed and surrounding area.
 - Playing the 9th you are out of bounds if your ball is left of the white stakes between the 8th & 9th fairways - the out of bounds extends from the first to the last white marker stakes. The white stakes are immovable obstructions. Relief as in Rule 24-2b.
PENALTY - Stroke and distance. The quarry in front of the 9th green is a water hazard - Relief as Rule 26-1.
- 2. MINE SHAFTS**
- All mine shafts within the boundaries of the course are integral parts of the course and not obstructions under Rule 24. There is therefore no relief.
- 3. STAKED TREES**
- A ball coming to rest in or so adjacent to staked trees or trees protected by a plastic sheath or wire netting, that the playing of the ball would cause damage to such trees **MUST** be lifted and dropped within one club-length of where it lay but not nearer the hole. Rule 24-2b(i) applies.
- 4. TRACTOR AND WHEEL MARKS**
- A ball coming to rest in any deep rutted tractor or wheel mark, anywhere on the course, may be lifted and dropped within one club-length but not nearer the hole, without penalty.
- 5. BUNKERS**
- Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions - relief may be taken under Rule 24.
- 6. RULE 24- OBSTRUCTIONS**
- All the artificial surfaces on all the paths and roads within the boundaries of the course. **NOT** the naturally worn paths on the cliff edges. Fixed sprinkler heads, manhole covers or junction boxes are immovable obstructions - Rule 24-2 applies.
- 7. TEMPORARY GREENS**
- At all times when temporary greens are in play a player may tap down any uneven surface on the line of the putt without penalty.
- 8. GROUND UNDER REPAIR**
- Grass cuttings and other material left on the course which have been abandoned are not intended to be removed and are not ground under repair. If a ball comes to rest in an area marked Ground Under Repair (white painted areas) the ball **MUST** be lifted as in Rule 25-1. Exception - if a dropping zone is clearly marked the ball **MUST** be dropped in the zone.
- 9. PRESERVATION AREAS**
- All temporary greens, the green 14a (adjoining the 15th fairway) except when 14a replaces a hole out of play, are declared to be areas requiring preservation. A ball coming to rest in such areas **MUST** be lifted and dropped within one club-length of where it lay but not nearer the hole, without penalty.

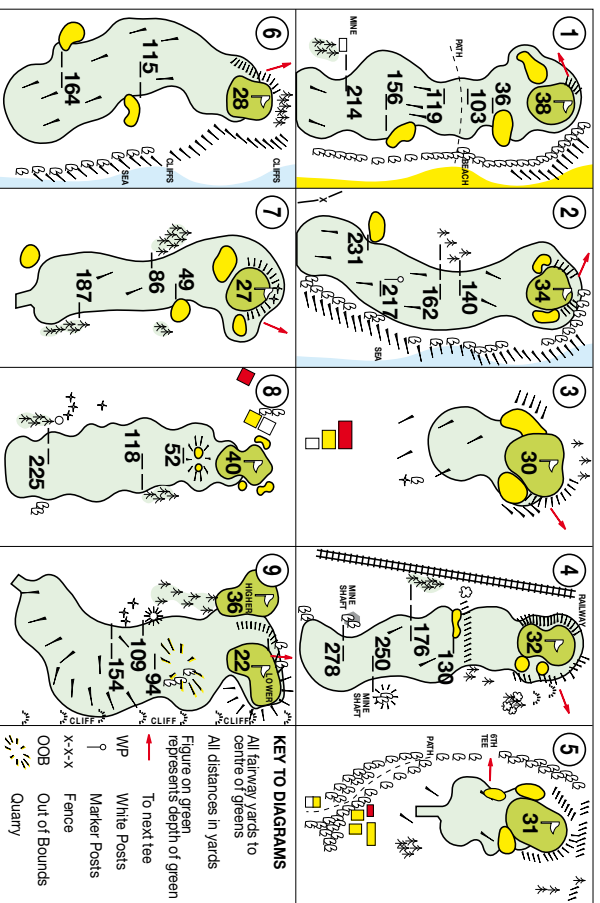

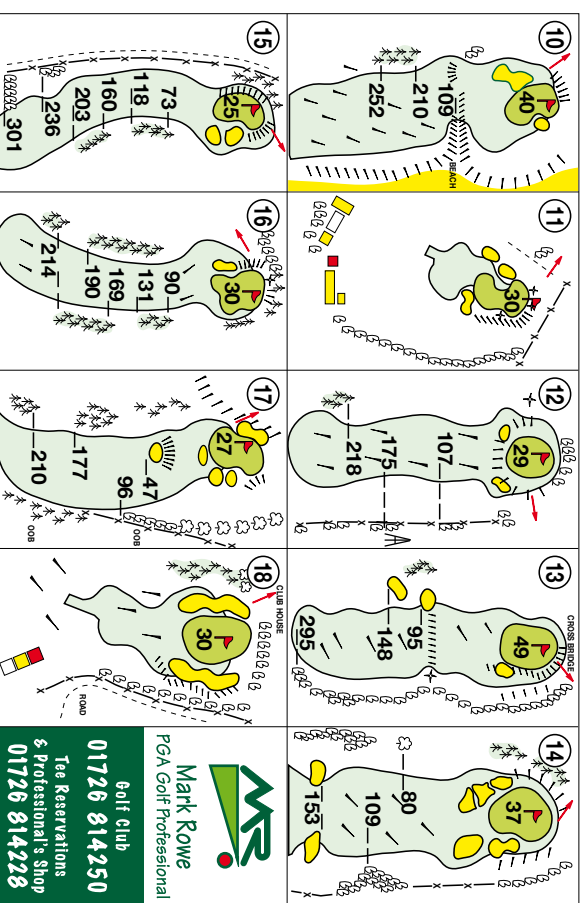

GOLFERS BEWARE

- I draw your attention to the following information covering **Health and Safety** when playing on this course.
- Special attention** should be given to the following holes, and always follow Golf etiquette when on the course.
- 1st** Be aware of the public right of way across the first hole from left to right.
- 2nd** The coastal path runs along the length of the 2nd hole on the right, be aware of the public.
- 4th** Beware of the mine shafts and approaching trains near this hole.
- 6th** The coastal path runs along the length of this hole on the right,
- be aware of the public and the cliff edge.
- 7th & 8th** This hole needs special attention as people are playing on either side of this fairway. Please be **extra vigilant** when playing in this area.
- 9th & 10th** Beware of the public on the coastal path on the right side of these holes.
- 14th** When teeing off, beware of the public right of way with vehicles and public approaching from left and right.
- 14th (A)** When in play beware of golfers approaching on or around the 15th tee.
- 15th** When playing from this tee be aware of golfers on or near the 16th green on the right hand side. When on or around the 15th green be aware of golfers teeing off on the 16th.
- 17th** Beware of traffic when going from the 17th to the 18th via the bridge. If using a buggy, follow the rules supplied with the vehicle.
- 18th** Hole beware of the public right of way in front of the tee and traffic on the road to the right.
